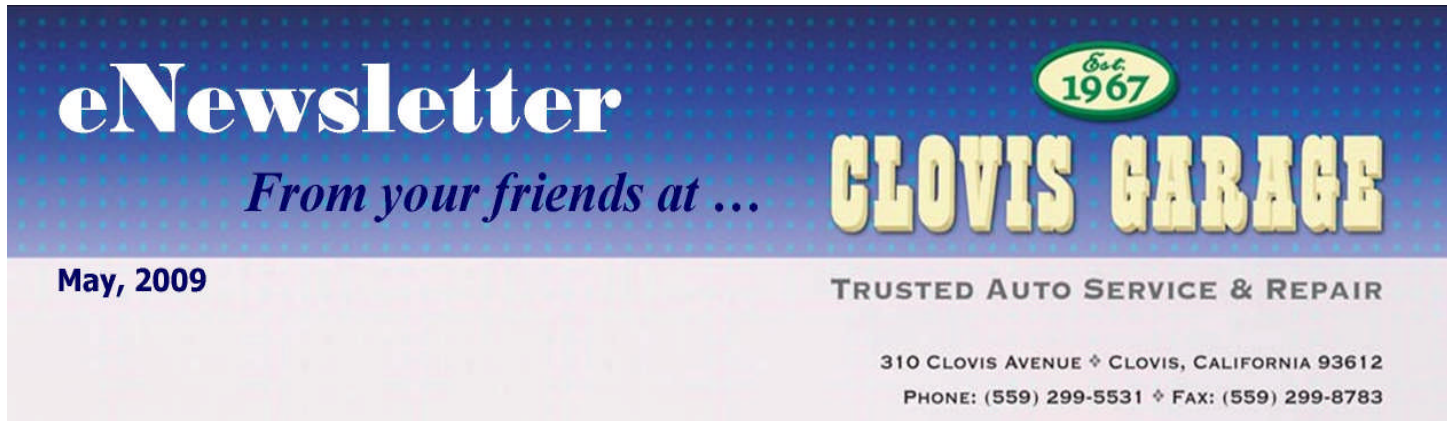

In Automotive News ...

- The youngest person to ever receive a traffic ticket was 23 month old Bobby DeSormier of Summerville, NY. Apparently, Bobby was driving his "Big Wheel" tricycle on the wrong side of the road on May 23, 1988 and caused an accident when his neighbor swerved and crashed to avoid hitting him. Bobby wasn't hurt, but he did get a traffic citation for his faux-pas. *(I wonder if his rates went up?)*
- Researchers are working on window glass that can "self-regulate" the amount of sunlight it lets in. On cold days, the glass could be adjusted to let a maximum amount of light and heat through, trapping the sun's warmth inside cars or buildings. On hot days, the sun would be reflected away, to help in cooling inside spaces. Known as electrochromic (or SMART) glass, the technology uses electric current to vary the transparency of special materials sandwiched within the glass. Sunroof panels would be the first likely use in automobiles.
- Remember the seat belt system that wouldn't allow you to start your car until the seat belt was buckled? People would just leave the belt buckled and then sit on it. Well, according to Auto Week, the idea is back and has gone high-tech. Microprocessors will now detect seat pressure before and then after the latching of the belt, as well as the distance that the belt is extended. *(Is this more information than you had wanted to share with your car?)*

Important Safety Tip:

According to the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, 47 children were killed under automatic garage doors in the last 10 years. Many more are crippled and injured each year. (Not to mention injury to pets.) Quality garage door openers has a sensitivity adjustment which will automatically open the door if an obstacle is encountered before the door is fully closed. Periodically test your unit by placing an empty soda can under the door as it is closing. The garage door should reopen before the can is crushed. If not, adjust the unit until it does (Consult your owners manual or the manufacturer for more details.) .Also, warn your young people of the dangers of playing with or trying to run or rush under a closing door.

Do you think our local rush hour is bad? Hong Kong has over 300,000 motor vehicles registered for its 867 miles of roads. This gives the city a density of just over 15 feet of roadway per vehicle!
